We are well into November and moving at what feels like a rapid pace. With only 4 weeks left until we have our winter break, it seems like so much has been happening here at Dragon Lake.

- The lunch buffet is a big hit with students and we are working out the kinks as they come along. We have altered our lunch on Wednesdays to accommodate the buffet. Students eat at 12:00 then head outside by 12:25. We have started homework club and games day in the library Monday Thursdays. The volleyball teams are about to wrap up their season which means Basketball is just around the corner.
- The weather seems to be inconsistent and a bit of an adjustment. If the temperature is -15 or colder, then we will have inside days. We always take into account the wind chill factor and make our assessments just prior to being outside. It seems that for all our efforts there is not a lot of change happening when it comes to playing competitive games outside or in gym classes. We will continue to teach problem solving skills using a variety of programs and strategies but we need parent support as well if we are going to make changes.
